James P. Kenyon, one of the oldest men in [the] town of Morris died last week Wednesday aged eighty-eight years and three months. He was born in Cooperstown in 1822¹. He went to Morris when five years of age and has always made his home there. In 1847 he married Miss Pamela Pearsall who died five years ago². One son survives [Lynn B. Kenyon of Morris]. One son [Charles L., 9 Dec 1847—2 Apr 1865] and one daughter [Lillie, 6 Jun 1850—27 Jan 1867] died many years ago. His funeral was held at the house, Sunday afternoon, with Masonic service by the Commandery of Knights Templar of Norwich and assisted by the Rev. F. [Frederick] G. Leonard of the Universalist church of which he was a member. Burial in the village cemetery beside his wife and children.—Our Morris Reporter.
