CASSADAGA, Aug. 12.—Mrs. Sarah Spicer Landers died at her home, 27 Main street, Tuesday after a lengthy illness. She was born at Whitesville, Nov. 11, 1869, the daughter of John Spicer and had resided in Cassadaga for 39 years. She is survived by her husband, Frank F.
