Mrs. Inez Howe Lord, descendant of early Rochester families, died today (May 19, 1945) at her home, 316 Oxford.

Mrs. Lord was the daughter of Harley J. Howe, of the Howe Scale Company, now Rochester Scale Works, one of the oldest Rochester business firms still in existence. Her mother was Mary Mahala Wadsworth Howe.

Howe [Alice Bergener] Kiefer, both of Rochester [both having been children of Inez and her first husband William Kiefer, whom she married in 1889]; three grandchildren, two great-grandchildren and two nieces, Mrs. W. Halbert Wright of Geneva and Mrs. Julius Kaelber of Pt. Washington.

Private funeral services will be held Monday afternoon in the home. Burial will be in Mt. Hope Cemetery.
