Sunday morning, April 3, Dora Beatrice, daughter of Milo and Maria Downs and wife of Edward Mahar, died at the home of her parents, where she had been since the fire that occurred at the house where they were living. She was born Dec. 30, 1873 and had always lived in or near the village, with the exception of a few months at Richfield Springs since her marriage. She was married Nov. 27, 1907. Previous to her marriage she was a member of the Universalist church and an enthusiastic worker in it and the societies connected with it. She was a very sweet singer and a valued member of the choir. She possessed a kind and lovable disposition and winning ways. Besides her husband and parents she leaves two little daughters, [Eileen?] Marie and Irene Beatrice, the latter but a few days old; also a brother, Lowell J Downs, of Little Falls. She was a niece of S. J. Downs and J. M. Brown of Richfield Springs and of H. A. Watson of this place.
