Harry R. Marble

Hon. Harry R. Marble, 81, of Baptist Hill, died at his home on Sunday, June 16, 1957.

He was active in Republican politics for thirty years, serving in several different offices: an assessor in the Town of Bristol for seven years; supervisor of the town for six years; Member of Assembly from Ontario County for twelve years; member of the Ontario County Republican Committee for twenty-seven years.

He served on the Board of Trustees of the Bristol Universalist Church for eighteen years; he was a member of Bristol Valley Grange and of Ontario County Pomona Grange, and had served as county deputy.

He had taught school, operated a farm, and owned and conducted a store at Baptist Hill.

He leaves his wife, the former Effie Mae Cottrell, whom he married in February, 1900; one daughter, Mrs. Harold Thomas, of Gorham; two sons, Earl R. Marble, of Bristol; and Dr. Dean R. Marble, of Ithaca; sixteen grandchildren and nine great-grandchildren.

A Masonic service was held at 8:30 p.m. on Tuesday, and services from the Bristol Universalist church on Wednesday at 4:00 p.m., conducted by Rev. Hardy Lumb, pastor. Burial in Bristol cemetery.
