C.D. Martin Dies In Honeoye Falls; Kin of Pioneers

Clarence (Clair) D. Martin of Honeoye Falls, member of a pioneer Lima family, died yesterday (Dec. 13, 1958) in Genesee Hospital. He was 83.

Mr. Martin farmed in the Honeoye Falls area for many years before he retired. He was born in North Bloomfield and lived in that area all his life. His parents, the late Mr. and Mrs. Dwight Martin, were early settlers in North Bloomfield, Town of Lima.

A 50-year member of the Union Star Lodge, F&AM, Honeoye Falls, Mr. Martin attended the First Presbyterian Church in Honeoye Falls. At one time he played the violin in a small orchestra and was active in the choir of the former Universalist Church of North Bloomfield.

He is survived by a brother, Irving Martin of Chili, and two nephews.
