MRS. ALMA MAYNARD DIES AT CALCIUM
Brownville Chapter, O.E.S. to Attend Burial at Dexter

Mrs. Alma M. Maynard, wife of George N. Maynard, died Thursday night at the family home at Calcium, where she had been ill for some time. Mrs. Maynard was 79 years of age and was born at Brownville.
