NEWS OF MACEDON

The death of Charles Richard Parker occurred Thursday, Nov. 4, at the home of his sister, Mrs. Abner D. Beal. Mr. Parker was formerly a highly respected resident of this town but since 1887 had made his home in Chicago. He was born in Bristol Sept. 14, 1855, the son of the late Mr. and Mrs. Richard Parker who were also residents here for several years. In 1898 Mr. Parker was married to Mrs. Jane Mcree of Chicago, who passed away about two years ago. In July he came to visit his relatives and attend the Parker family reunion, but was too ill on reaching here to attend the reunion and has been in failing health since that time. He made for himself many friends by his kind and genial ways, and will be greatly missed not only by his immediate relatives but by all who knew him best. He leaves one stepdaughter, Mrs. Carl Leverage, of Chicago; four sisters, Mrs. Lena Palmer, of Rochester, Mrs. Anna Peck, of West Bloomfield, Mrs. Susan Worden and Mrs. Harriet Beal, of Macedon; four brothers, Perry J. Parker, of St. Louis, Fred Parker, of Fairport, Edward Parker and David Parker of this village; also eighteen nieces and nephews. The funeral service was conducted by Rev. A. [Adelbert] E. Allison, assisted by the Rev. W. B. Rozell, at the Universalist church Sunday afternoon and burial made in the village cemetery.
