Albert O. Parshall

The death of Albert O. Parshall, which occurred at the Parshall Hospital in Oneonta, Saturday, September 6th, where he had been a patient sufferer for over three months, removes one of the oldest and most highly esteemed residents of the town of Middlefield.

Mr. Parshall was the son of Gilbert Parshall and Abbey Coffin Parshall and he was born in the town of Middlefield, April 17, 1835. To them were born nine children, Albert O. having been the last survivor. He was united in marriage with Mathilda Kaple, October 26, 1858, and her death took place April 20, 1919, after they had lived together for over sixty years. To them were born five children of whom 3 survive: Gilbert, who lives at home, Mrs. Howard Clark of Middlefield and Fred C. Parshall of Plattsburg. He had been a prosperous farmer during the long years of his active life and retired about ten years ago, but while he gave up his life work he retained his happy disposition until the end.

The funeral was held at the home of his daughter, Mrs. Howard Clark, Tuesday, September 9th, at 2 p.m., [the Rev.] George C. Boorn, pastor of the Universalist church, officiating. Interment in Lakewood cemetery.
