Alice May George, wife of Jason M. Peck, passed away at her home last Friday morning at 1:15.

Mrs. Peck was born in Morris, October 17, 1874, the only child of Peter and Rosetta Allen George. There she made her home until her marriage to Mr. Peck September 17, 1891, when she moved to Pittsfield, where she lived until June, 1932, when she and her husband moved to Laurens.

[On] November 5, 1933, she suffered a paralytic stroke from which she never fully recovered. Thursday she lapsed into unconsciousness from which she did not rally. She had a deep love for the literature and a keen understanding and appreciation of the beautiful. She was a good mother and a devoted wife. Her loss will be deeply mourned. Surviving are her husband, two sons, LaVerne of Laurens and Robert of Binghamton.

Funeral services were held from the home at 2 o'clock Sunday afternoon and interment made in the family plot in Hillington cemetery at Morris. The Rev. F [Frederick] G. Leonard, pastor of the Morris Universalist church, officiated.
