Lifelong Resident of Fort Plain Among Those Called

Fort Plain, Jan. 31—Joseph Pickard, 52, a lifelong resident of Fort Plain, died Wednesday afternoon in an Amsterdam hospital, where he had been for the last 10 days suffering from complications.

He was a son of Mr. and Mrs. George [and Mary Abbott] Pickard, had conducted hotels in this village and of late years had been a buyer of cattle.

He is survived by his wife [Madolin Moyer Pickard] and one step-son, Herbert Bernard of Fort Plain. A prayer service will be held from the late home Sunday at 2 p.m., and funeral services from Catherine Nellis Memorial Chapel at 2:30, Rev. Rufus H. Dix [of the Universalist Church] officiating. The remains will be placed in the vault until spring when interment will be made in Fort Plain Cemetery.
