DWIGHT C. PINNEY

Dwight C. Pinney, a retired manufacturer, who resided at 196 Lefferts place, died yesterday at the Skene Sanatarium. He had been out riding with a friend on Monday afternoon, when he was taken ill with what proved to be a stroke of apoplexy. He was removed to the sanitarium, where he died yesterday. He was born in Lockport, Saratoga County, N.Y., in April, 1852, and had lived in Brooklyn for about thirty-five years. Mr. Pinney had long been a member of the Universalist Church of Our Father, Grand avenue and Lefferts place, where he was for many years treasurer of the Sunday School. Mr. Pinney retired from business some time ago. The funeral will be private. He is survived by his widow, Caroline Williams Pinney; a daughter, Mrs. Henry Langdon Butler, and a granddaughter, Beatrice Pinney Butler.
