ALBA ROBINSON DIES IN HOSPITAL

Alba B. Robinson, 70, of 205½ N. Caroline St., died today in Herkimer Memorial Hospital, where he had been confined for six days.

He was born on Feb. 8, 1880 in Nicholville, a son of Edwin H. and Ollie Blake Robinson. He attended schools in Nicholville and was a graduate of Potsdam Normal School. He taught school in Nicholville and St. Regis Falls for several years.

His marriage to the former Miss Florence Drew took place on June 25, 1902 in St. Regis Falls. At one time, he managed the St. Clara Lumber Company in that village.

In 1914, he went to Oregon, where he was in the contracting business. He came back to this village in 1917 and worked as a cabinetmaker at the Standard Furniture Co. until he retired in 1945. Since his retirement, he had been associated with his sons in the Robinson Brothers Electrical Appliance Store, Mohawk.

Mr. Robinson was a member of the Mt. Arab Lodge No. 847, F. & A.M., Tupper Lake, and was master of the lodge in 1913 and 1914. He was treasurer of the carpenter's union at the Standard Furniture Co. from its organization until he retired. He attended the Universalist Church.

Besides his wife, he leaves two sons, Alton, Mohawk, and Lloyd, this village; one daughter, Mrs. Thomas Garito, Ilion; five grandchildren and one great-grandchild.

Funeral services will be conducted at 2 p.m. Saturday from the home, with the Rev. Stanley C. Stall, Universalist minister, officiating. Burial will be in Oak Hill Cemetery.
