Adams, Dec. 21.—Miss Armenia Rose, aged 73 years, died of dropsy early this morning at the home of her brother, Herbet Ross, with whom she lived in Park street. She had been [ill] for some time and was a great sufferer.

She was born at Henderson, the daughter of the late<sup>1</sup> Norman D. and R. T. Merla Churchill Rose. She had lived in this vicinity practically all her life. Miss Rose was a member of the Henderson Universalist Church. Her brother survives.

The funeral will probably be held Saturday afternoon at 2 from the home, Rev. F. J. Lavis of the Methodist Episcopal church officiating. Burial will be made at Evergreen cemetery, Roberts Corners.
