The death of Mrs. Electa J. Russell, one of the oldest residents of this village, occurred Saturday afternoon, at the home of her daughter, Mrs. G. N. [Cora] Hawley. She was seventy-nine years of age, and had resided in Webster over sixty years. Mrs. Russell was the widow of the late Alexis M. Russell, and was born in Phelps, October 3, 1825. She was the daughter of Philetus and Faronia [Fawnia] Swift, and a sister of Col. Henry Swift, at one time sheriff of Ontario county. She leaves three daughters, Mrs. N. R. Deyo of San Antonio, Texas, Mrs. N. L. Hendee and Mrs. G. N. Hawley of this place; also five grandchildren, Mrs. George Stevens and Martha Electa and Martha Swift Hawley of this village, and Carl Swift and Helen Electa Hallauer of Rochester. She also leaves many friends to mourn her loss, as she was much beloved by old and young. Funeral was held Wednesday afternoon at 2 o'clock, at the home of Mr. and Mrs. G. N. Hawley. Rev. I. K. Richardson of the Universalist church officiated. Interment in Webster rural cemetery.
