MRS. M. B. SANDERS DIES SUDDENLY Passes Away at Hospital While Awaiting Operation

Mrs. Minerva B. Sanders, widow of the late Frederic Sanders died suddenly in the Hepburn hospital at Ogdensburg on Thursday morning, February 3rd. Mrs. Sanders was in the hospital expecting to undergo a slight operation on her nose Thursday when she was seized with an attack of heart failure. Her health had not been good for some time.

Mrs. Sanders was born in Stockholm forty-six years ago, daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Hiram Ballou. She graduated from the Normal here and married Frederick Sanders, at that time a member of the faculty of Clarkson College. Mr. and Mrs. Sanders afterward resided in California, where his death occurred.

Mrs. Sanders returned here. Recently she was elected collector for the village and for the village school district known as union district number eight.

In these offices she was generally regarded as most efficient. She was a member of the Universalist church of this place, where services were held Sunday afternoon at 3, Rev. L. H. Garner officiating. The body was placed in the vault at Bayside pending interment in Buckton in the spring.

Mrs. Sanders is survived by two sons, Halford, a student at Harvard, and Vaughn, a student at Clarkson; by one sister, Miss Etta Ballou of this place; and by two brothers, Dr. F. H. Ballou of Washington, D. C. and Vernon Ballou of Stockholm.
