Mrs. Orville Seeger

The death of Mrs. Orville Seeger occurred at her home, No. 14 Beach street, Cooperstown, at about noon, Sunday, following a stroke of paralysis which she suffered Thursday night of last week.

The death of a daughter, Mrs. Florence Jack, which occurred about a month ago was a great shock to Mrs. Seeger and it is thought that the effect of this bereavement upon her mind was the cause that led to the stroke.

Alice M. Beardsley was born in Troy, August 9, 1851, the daughter of Franklin and Mary (Tuttle) Beardsley and she had been a resident of this village for the past forty-two years. [On] July 4, 1869, she was united in marriage with Orville Seeger who survives together with seven children, Mrs. Edwin Grover of Cooperstown, Mrs. A. J. Delemater of Hamden, Mrs. John Finch and Mrs. William Williams of Utica, Mrs. George Stamp of Elmira, Frank Seeber [Seeger], Syracuse and Lester Seeger of Des Moines, Ia., sixteen grandchildren and one great grandchild, who have the sincere sympathy of the entire community in the loss of a devoted wife and mother.

The funeral services which were private were held at the house, Wednesday afternoon at 2 o'clock, the Rev. George C. Boorn, pastor of the Universalist church officiating. Interment at Fly Creek.
