Funeral on Saturday for Accident Victim

SALISBURY—Funeral services for Gordon E. Seeley, 23, of Salisbury Center, will be at 2 tomorrow from the Nielsen Funeral Home, Dolgeville. Burial will be in Salisbury Rural Cemetery.

Mr. Seeley was killed in an auto accident early [on] April 4 on Route 29, north of Dolgeville.

Mr. Seeley suffered the fatal injuries when his car left Route 29, near the Hopson Road, north of Dolgeville. His death was the fourth traffic fatality in Herkimer County this year. Troopers J. G. George and Richard Novier said Mr. Seeley was northbound when the car went over a culvert and landed in a wooded area.¹

He was born in Johnson City, a son of Marshall and Edith Burke Seeley. He attended Dolgeville High School. He married Sherrill Bucenec in 1963 in Little Falls. He was last employed by the Harty-Parry Corp., Utica. He was a member of the Salisbury Center Universalist Church and the Dolgeville Rod and Gun Club.

Besides his wife, he leaves three sons, John Mashall, Gordon Emery, and Vincent Joseph, all at home; his parents; three brothers, Volney, with the Army at Fort Devens, Mass., Ward, Mayfield, and Terry, Salisbury Center; and two sisters, Mrs. Martha Montana and Miss Margaret Seeley, both of Salisbury Center.
