Mrs. A. T. Shorey, 76, Dies; Funeral To Be Held Sunday

Mrs. Ada Thompson Shorey, 76, for many years a leading figure in the work of the Universalist Church, here, and formerly president of the Metropolitan Women's Alliance of the church, died yesterday at her home, 47 Downing St., after an illness of several weeks.

Funeral services will be conducted at the home by the Rev. Dr. Thomas E. Potterton, pastor of the Universalist Church of Our Father, tomorrow afternoon at 3 p.m. Burial will be in Bridgton, Me.

Mrs. Shorey was a lifelong member of the Universalist Church and during the 25 years she made her home in Brooklyn had been a member of the Church of Our Father. She was born in Bridgton, Me., and was the widow of Frank Warren Shorey, publisher. She was a member and for several years president of the Maine Women's Club of New York and also was prominent for some years in the Cambridge Club. Two sons, Philip R. and Archibald T. Shorey, survive her.
