Mrs. Anna A. Smith

Mrs. Anna A. Smith, a resident trustee of the Chapin Home for the Aged and Infirm, Jamaica, died yesterday at the home, where she had been a member of the family for ten years. She had been a trustee of the home during the past forty-five years, and was widely known for her philanthropic work. Mrs. Smith was the widow of Daniel B. Smith, who died in 1869. She was born in Manhattan, in 1833, and was brought up in the old Universalist Church in Bleecker st. She was married in 1858. She became a member of the Universalist Church of the Divine Paternity, in Manhattan. After her husband's death she devoted her time largely to church and philanthropic work. She was once president of the Blue Anchor Society of Manhattan, and a member of the Sorosis. Funeral services will be held Friday at 11 o'clock a.m., in the Cooper Memorial Chapel of the Chapin Home, the Rev. Frank Oliver Hall; D.D., officiating. Interment will be in the family plot in Greenwood Cemetery. Mrs. Smith's home was at 6 Davis avenue, West New Brighton, S. I.
