Mrs. Harriet B. Spaulding, one of Albion's most estimable women, died Monday morning at her home in this village, after an illness of two weeks. She was the widow of Major E. M. Spaulding, and was born at Licking, Ohio, 73 years ago. She had been a resident of this village for the past 47 years. She was a member of the Pullman Memorial Universalist church and of the Ladies Aid Society, and was prominently identified with the social and charitable affairs of the village. She is survived by one son, Postmaster Louis M. Spaulding of this place. The funeral will be held from the home this afternoon at 3 o'clock.
