Dr. William Tibbitts.

One of the best known and active citizens of the town of Danube passed away Wednesday morning March 11th. We refer to Dr. William Tibbitts who had long been a resident of Newville. Dr. Tibbitts was born in Stillwater, Saratoga county, in 1838, and graduated from Bellevue medical college in 1867. Soon after his graduation he settled in Newville, and has since resided there. He was Republican in politics and was Supervisor of the town for five years from 1891 to 1895. He had also held other town offices. He was married to Elizabeth Houpt, who died a few years ago, and is survived by two sons, Henry and William D. Tibbitts, and by two sisters, Mrs. Susan Philips of Stillwater, and Miss Jane Tibbitts of Tacoma, Wash. He was a member of the County Medical Society. The funeral was held Saturday afternoon, Rev. Mr. Cutler, pastor of the Universalist church of Little Falls, officiating. Interment in Newville.
