Mrs. Van Evera Dies, Fifty-Four

Fort Plain, April 9—Mrs. Hudson Van Evera, aged 54, widow of the late Hudson Van Evera, a former resident of this village, died at her home in South Orange, N.J., of heart disease. The remains were brought to this village Saturday on the 2:17 train and were taken to the home of her mother, Mrs. Jacob C. [Jemima Van Patten Alsdorph) Nellis, by B. Gray & Sons. Besides her mother she is survived by one son, Morgan S. Van Evera, and one daughter, Miss Jane K. Van Evera of South Orange, N.J., and one half-sister, Mrs. W.W. Moyer of Bismark, North Dakota. The funeral was held from the residence Sunday afternoon at 2:30 o'clock, the Rev. Herbert F. Moulton [pastor of the Church of the Messiah, Universalist] officiating. Interment will be made in the Fort Plain Cemetery.
