FUNERAL SERVICES FOR MRS. VAN ZILE TO-DAY

Funeral service for Mrs. Sarah M. Van Zile of New York city, formerly of Syracuse, are to be held in the Church of the Divine Paternity [Fourth Universalist], New York, this afternoon at 4 o'clock, the Rev. Dr. Frank Oliver Hall officiating. The body will then be taken to Troy, where Mrs. Van Zile lived for many years, for burial. Services there will be performed by the Rev. Henry Neal Hyde, son-in-law of the deceased.

Mrs. Van Zile was the mother of the late Mrs. James Belden of this city; Edward S. Van Zile, the author; Harry Van Zile of Troy and Mrs. Henry N. Hyde of Little Rock, Ark., formerly of Syracuse. She lived in this city in the early nineties and was well known here, often visiting Mrs. Belden during the latter's lifetime. Mrs. Van Zile was 82 years of age and had been ill for more than a year. Death came Friday at her home in New York, No. 878 West End avenue. Besides her children Mrs. Van Zile leaves a sister, Miss Elizabeth Perry, formerly of Syracuse, but now residing with her nephew, August Belden, at South Orange, N.J.
