Cohocton, Sept. 9.—The death of Mrs. Cora Lyon Wagner occurred very unexpectedly at her recent home in Hornell, last Sunday morning about 10 o'clock, as the result which followed a stroke of apoplexy about 11 o'clock Saturday forenoon, and from which she failed to recover consciousness. Mrs. Wagner had been feeling unusually well and she was stricken without a moment's warning. She was the only daughter of Mr. and Mrs. John Lyon, of this village, where much of her life had been passed, and where her father's death occurred last December. Her age was nearly 45 years and her immediate survivors include her husband, James H. Wagner, to whom she was married in Cohocton about 25 years ago, two sons, Bert and Dale, of Hornell, her mother and her only brother, Floyd E. Lyon, both of this village, several aunts, cousins and other relatives in or near Cohocton. Funeral services¹ have been arranged for Wednesday at 3 o'clock in the Cohocton Presbyterian church, Rev. Clara Morgan, of the Hornell Universalist church, officiating.
