WALKER.

One of the city's oldest residents died on Monday in the person of Mr. John C. Walker of South Fourteenth avenue. Mr. Walker was 76 years old. He had lived in Mount Vernon for forty-two years, having come here when he was in the prime of life. He was well acquainted with the city's history and development. Mr. Walker was a widower, Mrs. [Elizabeth] Walker having died a few years previously. The funeral services were held yesterday afternoon, Rev. Frank L. Masseck, the former pastor of the Universalist Church, of which the deceased was a prominent member, officiating. The interment was at Eastchester Cemetery.
