(De Kalb Junction, Dec. 25). Mrs. Nancy D. Walker, died December 14, 1923 at the home of her daughter at Ellenville, N. Y., after two week's illness of pneumonia. She was born at Fairfield, Herkimer Co. N. Y. April 18, 1848, the daughter of George and Nancy Potter Lobdell; she was the eldest of three daughters in a family of five children, two sons and three daughters, and the last surviving member of the family. When a small child she moved with the family to St. Lawrence Co., settling on the farm now known as the Lobdell homestead. With the exception of several winters spent with her daughter at Ellenville she has been a life long resident of this place. Her husband died in 1912. Surviving are two children, Mrs. Eva Van Kirk of Ellenville and P. [Perley] L. Walker of this place. Funeral services were held from her home in this place, Monday, Dec. 17, at 1 o'clock p. m., her pastor, Rev. J. M. Payson of the First Universalist church of Canton, officiating, assisted by Rev. E. O. Webster of the Methodist church of this place. Interment in the family plot at Union cemetery.
