Entered into rest, Saturday night, December 19, 1908, Oliver James Walrath. Mr. Walrath had been ill for about a year preceding his death during which time he received the tender care of his son, L. E. Walrath, Esq., of this village, with whom he had resided for the past fifteen years. The deceased was seventy-six years of age and was born in the town of Otsego and had always resided in this vicinity. He is survived by the son mentioned, with whom he has made his home since the death of his wife [Alvira Miner Walrath] fifteen years ago, and by two brothers. The funeral was held Tuesday afternoon, the Rev. H. E. Kellington, pastor of the Universalist church officiating. Burial was made in Lakewood cemetery.
