Funeral services for William Waterman, aged 55 years, who died Thursday at a hospital in Utica were held Monday afternoon from the home at two o'clock and from the Catherine Nellis Memorial chapel at 2:30 o'clock. Rev. Dr. Herbert F. Moulton, pastor of the Universalist church officiating. The body was brought to this village Friday by undertakers A.G. Swartz and Son. Mr. Waterman had been in poor health for some time past. By occupation he was a cabinet maker and for many years was employed at the A. Hix Furniture factory here. He was a son of Alexander and Eva Lasher Waterman. The survivors are his wife, mother, one brother, Edward Waterman of Canajoharie; four sisters, Mrs. John Connine of Amsterdam, Mrs. William D. Ludwig and Mrs. Henry Minch of Fort Plain, Mrs. Henry Suits of Nelliston. Deceased was a member of the Sons of Veterans organizations.
