Mr. Whiting was born and educated in Brooklyn and was graduated from the New York Military Academy. He went into business after leaving school. Sixteen years ago he gave up business to enter journalism as assistant in the school department of the New York Globe. He had numerous friends in the city school system and in the newspaper world.

He lived at 412 East Eighteenth street with his wife and son, who is a student at Erasmus Hall High School. He was a member of All Souls Universalist Church.
